Monash Pharmacy Pre-registration course

In order to become a practicing pharmacist, the Pharmacy Board of Victoria requires graduates to undertake the equivalent of one year pre-registration supervised training followed by a registration examination. The one year of supervised training is a combination of practical 'on the job' training and completion of an approved pre-registration course. Monash University offers the educational component of the pre registration training.

The Monash Pharmacy Pre-registration course will assist pharmacy graduates in making the transition from student to independent, competent professional. The course has a very practical focus that helps students consolidate and build upon the knowledge and skills gained as an undergraduate and apply these to their practice as a pharmacist.

Monash University's Bachelor of Pharmacy and Bachelor of Pharmacy/Commerce are accredited by the Pharmacy Board of Victoria.
